With State Senators Ted Gaines (R) and Ricardo Lara (D) winning their November elections for State Board of Equalization and Insurance Commissioner, respectively, Governor Newsom has announced two special elections to fill the vacancies. The primaries for SD01 and SD33 are scheduled for March 26th. Candidates will run off on June 4th if no candidate receives 50%+1 of the vote in March.

CTGCA has been active in both districts throughout the past year+.


