

## IN THE NEWS WOMEN LAWMAKERS WRITE LAWS TO HELP FAMILIES

**This Mother's Day**, we want to acknowledge the contributions of mothers in the Legislature, who develop stellar policy that helps women and families throughout the state.

Several such legislators (pictured) made headlines this week when Governor

Newsom and the First Partner Siebel Newsom shared their <u>parents'</u> <u>agenda</u> proposal that includes many laws that lacked gubernatorial support in the past, including eliminating sales taxes on feminine products and diapers.

California's women legislators have been fighting for women's and family issues for many years, and they are thrilled to see more support under the new administration. For example, Assemblywoman **Cristina Garcia** wrote legislation to eliminate taxes on feminine hygiene products (a.k.a, the "tampon tax"). Assemblywoman **Lorena Gonzalez** authored legislation "to eliminate sales taxes on infant and toddler diapers sold in the state, [and she] praised Newsom's endorsement of the plan." Gonzalez notes, "This is something that will affect every single parent in California."
