One hundred years ago, on June 4th, 1919, the **19th Amendment** passed, granting women the right to vote. **In that first 1919 election following ratification, Grace Dorris, Elizabeth Hughes, Anna Saylor, and Clara Cressingham ran and won seats in the California State Assembly.**

We at **Close the Gap California** are proud to share an anniversary with the 19th Amendment. In June 2013, nearly 100 women from across California met in Los Angeles to launch a campaign for equal representation in the California Legislature.

**In our 6th year, we saw women rise from 21% to 31% of the Legislature.** Fueled by our success and committed to the goal, we continue the fight for all women's political equality and gender parity in the California Legislature.
