Close the Gap California recruits progressive women to run for the State Legislature.

From the beginning, CTGCA has applied a three-part test to determine whether a prospective women candidate meets our criteria for "progressive:"

WHAT'S PROGRESSIVE?

CTGCA recruits women who are pro-choice and committed to:



Close the access gap to contraception and affordable reproductive healthcare



Close the funding and achievement gaps in education



Close the wealth gap and craft pathways out of poverty

Is she pro-reproductive justice? Does she prioritize public school funding? Will she work to alleviate poverty?

Liberty, equality, opportunity.

Some of our progressive allies apply additional screens to make this determination, and we recruit in consultation with them, but we put these three forward because they prioritize women and children, while enabling us to recruit values-driven women in purple and red districts.

Since CTGCA has been recruiting, California has made progress. Early childhood education, equal pay, "yes means yes," child care expansion, women on boards, combating sexual assault, expanding voting rights, job protections, and health care access-- and many other initiatives to improve the lot of women-- are central to policy discussions.








UPTICK IN WOMEN'S POLITICAL ENGAGEMENT IN 2020
