Historic Leap Forward for Women in CA Legislature!

We did it! Thanks to your support and dedication, <u>women are on track to gain 8</u> or more seats in the CA Legislature in 2018. This tremendous gain brings women from 21% of the Legislature in 2017 up to 28% in 2018. After more than a decade in the bottom third of the country, CA now vaults above the national average of 24% women in state houses. A quantum leap and historic rebound!!

Previously, the most women added in a single year was 5, in 1978, 1992 and 1998. Yes, in 2018 we have even outdone 1992, "The Year of the Woman."

Progressive women are on track to replace their male predecessors in 8 state legislative districts we targeted for 2018. The success of our recruits, over 80% of whom were women of color, contributes to CA's leadership on that front: women of color make up 17% of the Legislature, almost triple the national average of 6%. If initial results hold, we have 4 new Latina Senators!

Targeted Recruiting Works

CTGCA targeted 12 districts for 2018. Progressive women launched viable campaigns in 11 of the 12 targeted districts (92%). As of this afternoon, 8 of those 11 have either won already or are in position to win (72%). 75% of them are women of color.


We are on our Way to Gender Equality




