Q2 Report: More Great Women Stepping Up To Run



WE'VE ADDED TARGET DISTRICTS AND CANDIDATES

We increased the number of <u>target districts</u> from 16 to 20. Among these 20 seats, 15 progressive women are now running in 11 districts. Twelve are women of color.

We expect prospects completing explorations with us to make decisions in 3 additional districts before Labor Day.


