## No women on the bench = No women on the team = No women leaders



**FEWER** women serve in the CA legislature today than a decade ago. Without intervention, that trend will continue. Consider:

- Women are in the "top two" of just 37 of 100 legislative races this fall.
- 20 women are leaving the legislature in 2014 and 2016 and we must replace them simply to stop the slide.

The bench is thin and we need recruits. See our **16 in '16** priority seats.

- Historically 30 of 92 CA women legislators served on city councils, women today hold only 28% of city council seats statewide.
- 71 CA cities have no women on their councils. (See a <u>new study by CA Women Lead and the Women's Caucus of the League of California Cities</u>)
- Just 7 women legislators served on a county board of supervisors, and 17 counties have no women serving. (Find out where the women legislators got their start.)
