On Our Toes -

▶ Our growing network allowed us to swiftly recruit outstanding women to run in AD 25 (Bay Area) and AD 72 (Orange County).

Momentum Building in NorCal -

- ▶ A CTGCA recruit competed in a special election in AD1 (Redding), a longtime GOP stronghold, and advanced to the run-off. The primary results suggest there is growing momentum for new ideas and voters' desire to elect more women!
- ▶ Lead Recruiter Janet Cook traveled to the Redding Rancheria to deepen connections with California Tribal women.


